

Dr. Odile A. van den Heuvel is psychiatrist at the VU University Medical Center (VUmc) in Amsterdam (The Netherlands). In 2005 she finished her PhD thesis (with honor) based on the investigation of the frontal-striatal and limbic circuits in OCD and related disorders, using neuroimaging. In 2007 she was awarded the prestigious NWO VENI award for an innovative study on emotion regulation in OCD, using repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation (rTMS) in combination with brain imaging (collaboration with dr. van der Werf, VUmc, and dr. Mataix-Cols, London). Her clinical and research interest is neuropsychiatry, with a main focus on OCD and related disorders, and Parkinson's disease. She currently coordinates the international initiative 'mega-analysis of OCD and anxiety brain imaging group', a highly powered study of pooled structural MRI scans to study brain morphometry in OCD.
