

**Dr. Brenda W.J.H. Penninx**

Brenda Penninx is Professor of Psychiatric Epidemiology at the VU University Medical Center and GGZinGeest in Amsterdam, the Netherlands. She is the principal investigator of the Netherlands Study of Depression and Anxiety (NESDA, [www.nesda.nl](http://www.nesda.nl)), a large-scale, multi-site, prospective study on the course of depression and anxiety disorders. In her research, she has examined genetic, biological and psychosocial determinants as well as the (somatic) consequences of depressive and anxiety disorders. On these topics, Dr. Penninx has written over 300 scientific papers, which have been well cited (H-index=50). She is a member of the Young Academy of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Sciences and Arts. Her research group consists of 4 post-docs and >20 PhD-students.
