David Baldwin is Professor of Psychiatry in the Division of Clinical Neurosciences and Head of the Mental Health Group, in the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Southampton in the United Kingdom. As Honorary Consultant Psychiatrist with Hampshire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust, he leads the Mood Disorders Service based at College Keep in Southampton. He trained in medicine at Charing Cross Hospital Medical School, London and then in psychiatry at St Mary's Hospital Medical School and the Maudsley Hospital, London.

He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Psychiatrists, a Fellow of the CINP, a Fellow of the UK Higher Education Academy, a Fellow of The Royal Society of Arts, and a Member of the ECNP. Since 2007 he has been the Chair of the Psychopharmacology Special Interest Group of the Royal College of Psychiatrists. He was Secretary for External Affairs of the British Association for Psychopharmacology, having occupied that post between 2000/03 and 2005/07. He was Deputy Chief Examiner of The Royal College of Psychiatrists; a Past President of Depression Alliance; and is a Medical Patron of Anxiety UK. He was Joint Editor of *International Journal of Psychiatry in Clinical Practice* between 1997 and 2010, and became Editor-in-Chief of *Human Psychopharmacology* in January 2011.

Through his research activity and clinical practice, Prof. Baldwin aims to improve clinical outcomes in patients with mood and anxiety disorders: by investigating the role of neurobiological and psychological factors in causing and maintaining illness; through improving trial design when evaluating efficacy and tolerability of treatment interventions; by assessing the effectiveness and acceptability of treatment interventions in wider clinical practice; through identifying more accurately those patient groups at particular risk of poor outcomes; and by offering a tertiary referral specialist clinical service to patients with chronic and treatment-resistant conditions. He leads the Anxiety Disorders Research Network, an international multi-centre independent collaborative cross-disciplinary research grouping, with support from the ECNP. He is the author of over 200 full articles in peer-reviewed scientific journals, and author or co-author of 8 books and 34 chapters in books.
