Eric Vermetten, MD, PhD, psychiatrist/psychotherapist. He is Officer in the Dutch Army and head of Research of the Military Mental Health Services, Department of Defense and Associate Professor Psychiatry at the Neuroscience Division, University Medical Center Utrecht. His group is interested understanding trajectories for the development of deployment-related disorders, its biological basis and strategies for early prevention.
